Front: Aufrechter, nach l. schreitender Bär mit Halsband; in Kreislinie.

Rear: Bekrönter Doppeladler mit Reichsapfel mit Wertziffer 3 auf der Brust; in Kreislinie.

Provenience: Altbestand (vor 1871)

Field smoothed: The field of a coin or medal has secondarily been fully or partly deepened in order to improve the relief of the legend or image. This procedure occurs especially with collectors' objects and is not part of the working process of a mint. Not to be confused with the re-cutting of parts of the design or legend on a coin, or the erasure of elements of them.
