Front: Kopf des Herakles nach r. mit Löwenfell. Über dem Ohr Gegenstempel mit Anker.

Rear: Zeus nach l. auf Thron sitzend mit Adler und Zepter, im Feld l. KH (= Jahr 28).

Provenience: A. Prokesch von Osten

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
