Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Gallienus nach r. mit Lorbeerkranz. Gegenstempel € (5 Assaria).

Rear: Tempelbezirk mit drei Tempeln, zwei in Seitenansicht einer in Vorderansicht mit einer Reiterstatue, im Giebel A, um zentralen Platz, darauf ΝΕΩΚΟ / ΡΩΝ.

Provenience: Slg. Imhoof-Blumer (Kauf bei A. O. van Lennep, 1906)

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
