Front: Grosskönig im Knielauf nach r. mit Bogen und Lanze, Köcher über Schulter. Kratzer.

Rear: Reiter nach r. mit erhobener Lanze. Kratzer und Einhiebe.

Provenience: Slg. Bernhard, aus Slg. Imhoof-Blumer (Kauf bei van Lennep, 1896)

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
