Description

Front: Solothurner Wappenschild zwischen S – O, darüber Reichsadler; Vierpass mit Lilienornamenten in den Zwickeln. Gerstenkornkreis.

Rear: Ganzbild des nimbierten heiligen Ursus in Harnisch und Helm, mit Schild und Lanze. Gerstenkornkreis.

Provenience: Slg. Imhoof-Blumer (aus Slg. Lohner, angekauft von Imhoof-Blumer, 1866)

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
